63% of Year 11s have already secured a post-16 destination, including college, apprenticeships, and employment.

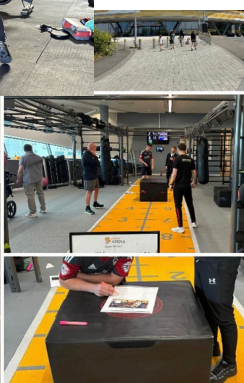
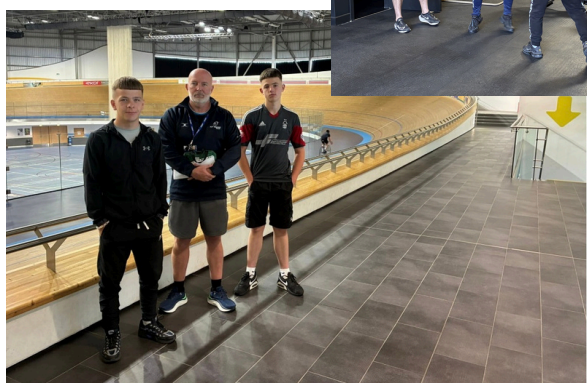
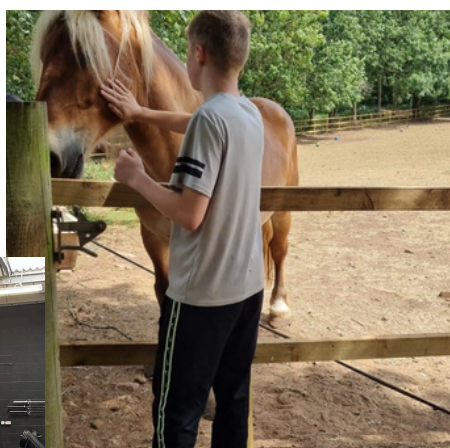
All Year 11s received one-to-one career guidance and support with applications.

## Inclusion & Personalised Support

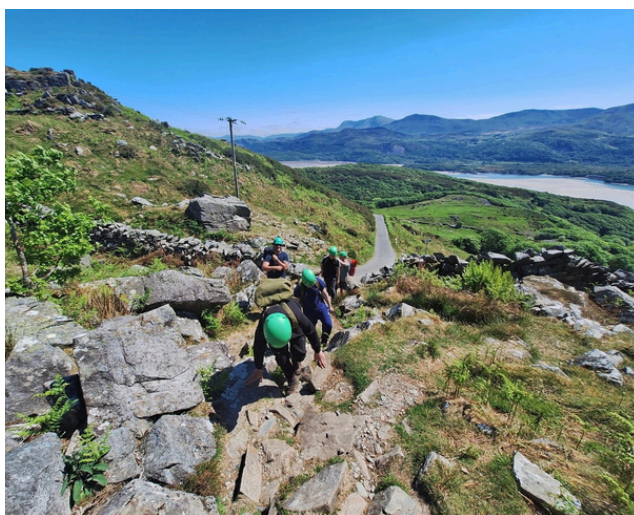
